The NSW Council of Christians and Jews is among 24 community groups who have banded together to urge the NSW government to overhaul its race-hate legislation.

Keep NSW Safe is a coalition of communities which has come together to call for change to the State's race-hate legislation.

The campaign urges the government to "protect us all against extremists who promote violence based on race, colour, descent, or national, ethnic, or ethno-religious origin. The government needs to act."

The coalition says it "is asking the NSW Parliament to act to preserve our peaceful way of life by changing the law to protect communities from the promotion of violence."
